

Please read these procedures for registration.

We are selling tickets by “mail-in”. **As tickets go on sale June 1st**, we will be registering attendees by the date on the Post Mark of the Stamp. Any mail-ins postmarked before June 1st, 2007 will be returned un-opened. **The Activities Subcommittee will be honoring the registrations by the date on the postmark.** We will be checking the P.O. box mid June and will call you to let you know what your status is. **Your tickets will be mailed to you so please enclosed a Self Addressed Stamped Envelope. Also include your phone number so we can call you!**

Your tickets are not refundable. If you want to sell your registration you must transfer your ticket. Do not loose them. They are your only proof that you paid for the event! **Bring the tickets with you to the event and you will be issued “Event Badges”** when you check in. There will be different “Event Badge” colors between Adults and Children. If you transfer a child’s ticket to an adult, that ticket can be upgraded to an Adult Badge for the balance of \$25 when the person checks in at the Campground. The badges will be required to stay overnight at the campout and to attend the meals include with the event. **All Campers must be registered!**

We have allotted spaces for newcomers; however, if you have to cancel at the last moment, please let us know as this will open up more spaces for newcomers. If you have extra camping gear, tent, sleeping bags, etc... to help facilitate the needs of the newcomer please let us know.

It takes a group effort to put on this event and in the spirit of Unity; everyone has 2 chores during the weekend. **You will sign up for your chores when you check in.**

Parking is NOT included with your reservation. If you show up at the event after dark or after the ranger check-in station is closed, please be sure to check in the next morning as to avoid a parking ticket.

In the spirit of fairness, **there are no “saving spaces” for others.** If you are asked to save a space, you will need to set their tent up. **There are no dogs allowed at the event.** We do not provide any childcare. **You will be responsible for the supervision of your own children.**

Our sites are “Cabrillo” and “Ortega – it is open to us at 2 pm on Thursday, Sept. 25th. You will not be able to get in before 2 pm. **If you show up before 2 pm.... You will be asked to wait at the gate.** We must be out by 12 noon on Sunday, Sept. 28th.
